6-MONTHS SUMMARY -- OCTOBER 2001 THROUGH MARCH 2002 AND CASES CLOSED MARCH 2002

NOTE: This monthly report lists the outcome of secret-ballot voting by employees in NLRB-conducted representation elections as officially certified following resolution of postelection objections and/or challenges. This publication is distributed monthly on a subscription basis by the Government Printing Office.
