#### N.L.R.B. ELECTION REPORT

#### **CASES CLOSED OCTOBER 2001**

NOTE: This monthly report lists the outcome of secret-ballot voting by employees in NLRB-conducted representation elections as officially certified following resolution of postelection objections and/or challenges.
