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N.L.R.B. ELECTION REPORT

6-MONTHS SUMMARY -- APRIL 2002 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2002 AND CASES CLOSED SEPTEMBER 2002

NOTE: This monthly report lists the outcome of secret-ballot voting by employees in NLRB-conducted representation elections as officially certified following resolution of postelection objections and/or challenges. During FY 2002, the NLRB continued to improve its techniques for tracking and collecting case activity data. While significant efforts were made to verify the accuracy of the FY 2002 data, some inconsistencies can be found between some tables in these reports and in comparing data in the ER and Annual Report.
