Dear Dr. Taylor:

Thank-you for your letter dated Aug 4, 2003 regarding Bumble Bee's application to the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for a temporary permit to market test, in interstate commerce, canned tuna that will deviate for the standard of identity for canned tuna (Title 21 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 161.190)) in that lemon juice and lemon oil will be used as flavoring ingredients instead of lemon oil and citric acid with safe and suitable carriers. Also, the product will be labeled "in water, with natural lemon flavor" rather than "lemon flavored chunk light tuna." In all other respects, the test product will conform to the standard for canned tuna.

Attached please find the finished label that will be used during distribution of the test product. Each of the ingredients used in the food are declared on the labels are required by the applicable sections of 21 CFR part 101.

Bumble Bee will commence with national interstate shipments, for market testing purposes effective September 1, 2003.
