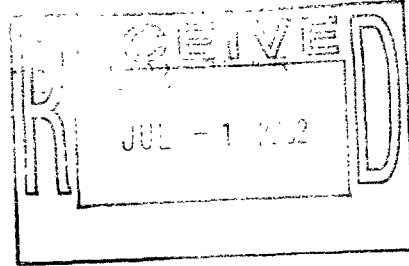

Dear Sir or Madam:

In accordance with the requirements of section 403(r)(6) of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, Melaleuca, Inc., notifies FDA that it has begun using the following statement:
