Dear Dr. Adams:

Please find attached the collective comments of the International Tree Nut Council Nutrition Research and Education Foundation (INC-NREF) to the California Walnut Commission Petition (Docket #02P-0292). The Almond Board of California (ABC) has worked with INC-NREF members for the past two years to assess the totality of scientific evidence supporting the cardioprotective evidence of nuts.

Since the inception of the ABC Nutrition Research Program in 1995, the Board has supported over \$4 million of clinical research in top U.S. academic institutions and abroad to evaluate the relationship between almond consumption, cardiovascular disease, and related risk factors. We were very pleased that seven almond clinical trials met the scientific criteria to be included in the INC-NREF petition that demonstrates that nuts, as a group, lower cholesterol and, thereby, reduce the risk of coronary heart disease.
