

Re: 21 U.S.C. Section 343(r)(6), Notification of Statements on Dietary Supplements

Dear Sir/Madam:

I hereby notify the Food and Drug Administration ("FDA") of the use of statements of nutritional support in the labeling of Carnosine, 500 mg, an antioxidant supplement.

## Statements being made in the labeling of Carnosine, 500mg

(1) Carnosine is a naturally occurring dipeptide consisting of β-alanine and histidine. It is found in high concentrations in long-lived cells such as neurons and myocytes (muscle cells) and levels decline with age. Carnosine exhibits antioxidant properties and protects structural proteins from detrimental age-related modifications. In the diet, carnosine can be obtained only from animal tissues. Therefore, carnosine supplementation may be important for vegetarians.
