How Do I Use The FAP?

Call **1-800-334-2178** to speak with our caring, professional staff about your concerns. Our intake staff will assess your needs and provide information and consultation. If needed, they will provide referrals to community resources, support groups, legal and financial specialists, and our network of counselors.

Who Is Eligible?

The EAP is available to you and your eligible family members.

Is It Confidential?

Yes. To ensure confidentiality, all services are provided by FEI Behavioral Health (FEI), an independent provider of EAP services. Information about your personal situation is protected within the limits of state and federal laws and will not be shared by anyone without your consent.

How Much Does The Service Cost?

The entire cost of up to 6 sessions per incident per year is covered by the National Transportation Safety Board. If additional assistance is needed, the counselor can help you explore referral options in line with your health care coverage and budget.
