In one case the child had been in care 24 days, but it was under a voluntary placement agreement. In the other record, the child had been in care since November 1998. The remaining six cases that were incorrect were due to children entering foster care under a voluntary placement agreement and then the agency needing to obtain a court order after the 180 day timeframe to obtain custody of the child. The AFCARS reports reflected a "court order" for manner of removal, not a "voluntary placement agreement."
