To Whom It May Concern:

I am aware that a coalition of 60 pro-abortion groups has filed a petition with the FDA, asking that morning-after abortion pills be made available over the counter. In addition, the maker of one abortifacient morning-after pill has launched a series of clinical trials in an effort to convince the FDA to let pharmacists dispense the drug without a doctor's prescription.

My message to you is a simple one: Don't do it! In fact, I ask you to withdraw these pills because they do not prevent abortion; they ARE abortion.
