Dear Commissioner:

I am writing with respect to the above dockets to urge the following points:

- 1. **Please require mandatory pre-market safety testing:** Genetically engineered foods could be toxic, could cause allergic responses, could have lower nutritional value, and could compromise immune responses in consumers.
- 2. Please require mandatory pre-market environmental review: Genetically engineered crops and foods could cause irreparable damage to the environment, so there needs to be pre-market environmental review.
- **3.** Please require mandatory labeling of genetically engineered foods: Without mandatory labeling, neither consumers nor health professionals will know if an allergic or toxic reaction was the result of a genetically engineered food. Consumers will also be deprived of the critical knowledge they need to hold food producers liable should any of these novel foods prove hazardous.
- 4. The proposed "Notification" policy is an insult to consumers: The current proposal irresponsibly ignores, strong scientific evidence of numerous potential health and environmental risks of genetically engineered foods. These rules appear to be a decision made to convenience industry at the expense of public health, consumer information, and the environment.
