I am writing to you with concern about two issues:

First - I urge you to ban the use of anti-biotics for humans in animal feed to make livestock grow faster. This is believed to be the principle cause of antibiotic resistance leaving doctors with fewer tools to combat human infection. The

European Union has banned this use and the WTO has called for its termination.

Second - I urge you to keep genetically-engineered crops off the market and out of our food supply until adequate testing demonstrates no harmful effect on human health or the environment. Genetically engineered crops

should be labeled and corporations should be held liable for any harm from the crops they manufacture.

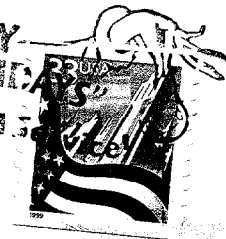
