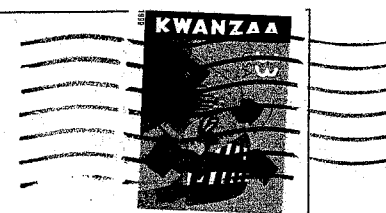
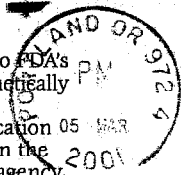
- All GE foods should be labeled so I am informed and have a choice.
