
Our Children, Our Future

3 million + obese children







EU - Marketing to Children

Unfair Commercial Practices - no direct exhortation to children to buy permitted and pester power outlawed
Television Without Frontiers- broadcasts may not impair physical, mental moral development of minors
EFSA -nutrition based dietary advice underway
Labelling - review of current rules on nutritional labelling
Voluntary - BBC characters nutritional criteria
Science - UK widely debated FSA report
