Dear CEQ FOIA Officer,

In accordance with the U.S. Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552) I am requesting copies of-all-records-related to or that reference the following:

- CEO internal documentation and/or correspondence to outside organizations, officials, or relevant parties concerning the Asia-Pacific Partnership for Clean Development and Climate.
- Negotiations and/or correspondence relating to any climate agreement proposals between the U.S. and any of the following nations: Australia, China, India, Japan and South Korea.
- Correspondence concerning the CEQ's efforts, plans or proposals to reduce greenhouse gas emissions that reference any other nations in addition to the ones previously listed.

I am requesting that you search for the above records for the time period from January 2004 to present.

I would also like to request that all charges for supplying the records I have requested be estimated in advance. I understand that if you determine that the charges are likely to exceed \$200, I may be obliged to pay that amount before you continue to process my request.

If you deny all or any part of this request, please cite each specific exemption that you believe justifies your withholding of information. Please be sure to notify me of appeal procedures available under the law in the event of any denial.
