The Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (Board) is pleased to announce the assignment of R. Todd Davis as a Board Site Representative at the Department of Energy's Y-12 National Security Complex (Y-12). Mr. Davis will be joining Don Owen, who is currently assigned as a Site Representative at Y-12.

As one of the Board's site representatives at Y-12, Mr. Davis will advise the Board with regard to overall safety and health conditions, and will participate in the conduct of Board staff reviews and evaluations related to the design, construction, operation, and decommissioning of nuclear facilities. He also will act as the Board's liaison with the Department of Energy and Y-12 management, federal, state and local agencies, the public, and industry officials.

Mr. Davis joined the Board in September 1994. He served as the Board's Site Representative at the Department of Energy's Savannah River Site (SRS) from March 1999 to the present. As a member of the Board's staff, Mr. Davis has conducted reviews and evaluated the health and safety impacts of electrical and instrumentation control systems at the Department of Energy defense nuclear facilities. He has also been responsible for staff activities related to the Idaho National Engineering and Environmental Laboratory, SRS high-level waste, SRS nuclear material stabilization, and numerous facility startup reviews.

Prior to joining the Board, Mr. Davis was a Naval Officer at Naval Reactors where he was involved in the design, operation, and maintenance of naval nuclear equipment. Mr. Davis has a MS degree in Electrical Engineering from Stanford University and a BS degree in Electrical Engineering from Auburn University.

Mr. Davis, his wife Angela, and three children will reside in the Oak Ridge area.
