REVISED ORDER RE MOTION FOR SUBPOENA ENFORCEMENT

Upon consideration of Respondent Intel Corporation's ("Intel") Motion for Enforcement of Subpoena *Ad Testificandum* issued to Wade Patterson and to Preclude Trial Testimony Pending Resolution of Dispute and the opposition thereto,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Intel's motion is DENIED for failure to comply with Rule 3.22(f) of the Commission's Rules of Practice (that the motion for enforcement be accompanied by a signed statement that counsel for the moving party has conferred with opposing counsel in an effort in good faith to resolve by agreement the issues raised by the motion and has been unable to reach such an agreement), and because the Court finds Mr. Patterson adequately answered Intel's questions during his three days of deposition testimony.
