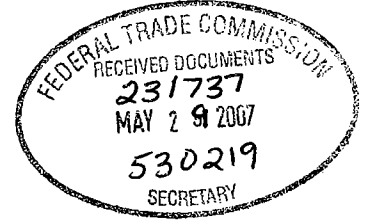

JOINT STIPULATION RE DESIGNATED DEPOSITION TESTIMONY

In addition to admitting these designations, the parties intend to call Karen Kage to testify live at trial and Respondent intends to call Douglas Hardy to testify live at trial.


4. The parties agree that the following witnesses shall be called by deposition in the event that they do not testify live at trial:




