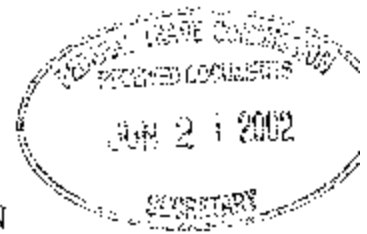

THIRD PARTY CESSNA AIRCRAFT CORPORATION'S
MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE MOTION
FOR *IN CAMERA* TREATMENT OF DESIGNATED HEARING EXHIBITS

Third party Cessna Aircraft Company ("Cessna"), by and through undersigned counsel, hereby files this Motion for Extension of Time to File Motion for *In Camera* Treatment of Designated Hearing Exhibits. Cessna seeks an extension of the deadline to submit its motion until June 21, 2002.

On May 30, 2002, Complaint Counsel advised Cessna that they intended to include documents produced by Cessna and deposition testimony exhibits of Cessna employees on their respective exhibit lists. The total number of both lists amount to 2700 pages. Complaint Counsel informed Cessna that it had until June 11, 2002, to make a motion to this court to request *in camera* treatment of any of these designated exhibits.

Cessna needs an additional extension of time to file a motion for *in camera* treatment due to the high volume of documents designated by Complaint Counsel on their respective exhibit lists. Cessna has reviewed the documents and narrowed the list of 2,700 documents down to approximately 725 that it believes will meet the standards for *in camera* treatment. However, counsel is out of the office and unavailable to prepare the motion and appropriate exhibits. The additional time will allow Cessna to determine exactly which documents and testimony meets the standards for *in camera* treatment.

Thus, Cessna respectfully requests that this court grant Cessna an additional ten-day extension to file its Motion requesting *in camera* treatment of certain documents and testimony. A proposed order is attached for the court's convenience.


