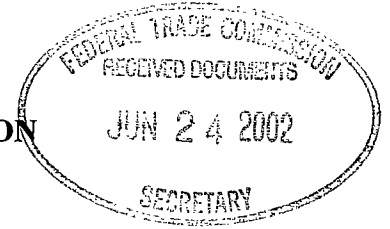

**MSC.SOFTWARE CORPORATION'S
MOTION TO AMEND THE SECOND REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER**

As this Court is well aware, this week brings with it a multitude of filings. On Tuesday June 25, alone, MSC is slated to file its Pretrial Brief, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, its motion for *in camera* treatment of both MSC's and Complaint Counsel's proposed trial exhibits, and its oppositions to Complaint Counsel's Motion *In Limine* to Bar Evidence of Efficiencies and Motion *In Limine* to Bar Evidence Treating Dassault as an Independent Competitor ("Motions"). As this Court is also aware, MSC has limited resources to devote to this litigation. As a result, MSC is requesting a six-day extension in which to file its opposition to the Motions. Counsel for MSC contacted Complaint Counsel to determine whether it opposes such an extension, and Complaint Counsel represented that it does not currently have an opinion to be relayed to Your Honor.

Such an extension would make these oppositions due on Monday, July 1, 2002, the same due day requested by Complaint Counsel for its oppositions to MSC's motions *in limine*. This date, however, is still before the Hearing set in the schedule for July 2, at 10am, where MSC is hopeful that these and MSC's motions *in limine* will be addressed.
