

ORDER DISMISSING CASE

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon a *sua sponte* review of the record. On May 23, 2007, the Court issued an Order [D.E. 40] requiring Plaintiff, the Federal Trade Commission (“the FTC”) to effect service upon Defendant, Jackson Sarcar (“Sarcar”), on or before July 23, 2007. The FTC was warned that failure to comply with the Order would result in the dismissal of its claims without prejudice without further notice.
