

- 1) S.J.Res. 22 Recognizing the Agricultural Research Service of the Department of Agriculture for 50 years of outstanding service to the Nation through agricultural research (Sen. Cochran / Rep. Goodlatte Agriculture)
- 2) H.R. 1367 To authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to conduct a loan repayment program regarding the provision of veterinary services in shortage situations (*Rep. Pickering Agriculture*)
- **3) H.R. 3217** To provide for the conveyance of several small parcels of National Forest System land in the Apalachicola National Forest, Florida, to resolve boundary discrepancies involving the Mt. Trial Primitive Baptist Church of Wakulla County, Florida (*Rep. Boyd -Agriculture*)
