# Central Contractor Registration http://www.ccr.gov



- All Federal Contractors must be registered in the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) to receive a Government contract, except:
  - Purchase Card buys
  - Classified contracts
  - Support to military/emergency ops
  - Unusual/compelling need
  - Foreign contracts outside U.S.
  - Micro-purchases that don't use EFT.

### FedBizOpps www.FedBizOpps.gov



- Governmentwide Point of Entry for electronic public access to procurement opportunities over \$25,000
- Government buyers post synopses of proposed contract actions, solicitations, other information
- Public can register/subscribe directly and can search, monitor and retrieve opportunities solicited by the entire Federal contracting community.

# E-Center http://e-center.doe.gov



- The E-Center is the <u>KEY</u> to doing business with DOE
- Provides detailed information on doing business with DOE, including:
  - viewing current business opportunities
  - registering to submit proposals
  - obtaining information and guidance on the acquisition/financial assistance award processes.
- Access tools to identify opportunities and where to market your capabilities

- DOE transitioning to a new paperless procurement system – STRIPES (Prism).
- FedConnect has the same capabilities as IIPS and is being used by DOE Headquarters, Strategic Petroleum Reserve, Naval Reactors and Yucca Mountain procurement offices.
- FedConnect is being used by multiple Federal agencies.
- Current and potential contractors and financial assistance recipients are requested to register with FedConnect at their earliest convenience.

- Find which products and services DOE buys
- Find program offices or buying offices that have awarded contracts in your areas of interest

### Get on the GSA Schedules



- DOE, like most agencies, are gravitating more to using Multiple Award Schedules
- DOE pioneered policy of targeting small businesses for schedule buys
- DOE conducts formal/disciplined market research to identify/select qualified firms
