Introduction

With more than 50 years of service supporting national security, the Nevada Test Site (NTS) continues to play a crucial role in sustaining domestic and global security. As part of the National Nuclear Security Administration Nevada Site Office (NNSA/NSO) public information efforts, a Speakers Bureau was established to educate the public about the technologically advanced activities occurring at the NTS, and its rich history.

Background

The NNSA/NSO Speakers Bureau program was developed and later formally introduced by the Office of Public Affairs in 2004. During its inaugural year, more than 5,200 audience members were reached in Clark County, Nye County, and Washington, D.C. To date, 441 presentations have been delivered to nearly 43,000 audience members.

Audience

The NNSA/NSO Speakers Bureau is a free service available to Southern Nevada civic organizations, educational groups, professional organizations, and

community groups. It is one of several community outreach methods used by NNSA/NSO to educate the public on the significant national security contributions made at the NTS.

Recognition

In addition to fulfilling specific community outreach and education objectives, the NNSA/NSO Speakers Bureau has received external recognition. The program has been honored with the Public Relations Society of America Tri-State Pinnacle Award and the Award of Excellence.
