 How a Flight Instructor, FAASTeam Representative or FAASTeam Program Manager (FPM) validates credit for a WINGS activity.

If a CFI does not have a **FAAsafety.gov** account, a WINGS Participant will have to contact another CFI, FAASTeam Representative or Program Manager for credit validation. If you are asked to validate training you have not given, the WINGS Participant is expected to show you proof of completion of the activity. You are validating that you have seen the documentation supporting the training; i.e. logbook entry or certificate.
