14	A packing slip or other suitable shipping document shall accompany each shipment and shall
15	show the (a) name and address of the consignor (b) name and address of consignee, (c)
16	Government purchase order (d) Government bill of lading number covering the shipment, if any,
17	and (e) description of the material shipped, including item number, quantity, number of
18	containers, and package number, if any.

20	D.3 FOB POINT

All reports called for in the contract shall be shipped by the Contractor to the Government F.O.B.
destination.
