New language

Program Procurement Guidelines

This is the MCC July 21, 2008 Edition of the Guidelines. Among the major changes to the July 21, 2008 Edition of the Guidelines please note the following:

- Attachment 1, Approval Requirements, of the Guidelines has been reorganized into Schedule A and Schedule B. Schedule A contains the current approval requirements matrix. Schedule B introduces a new matrix of substantially fewer number of MCC approvals.
- New MCC Standard Bidding Documents (SBDs). These SBDs are to be used by MCA Entities, even where an MCA Entity may have approved SBDs.
- Elimination or higher thresholds for MCC approvals in Schedule A of Attachment 1.
- Higher thresholds for the requirement to advertise Specific Procurement Notices at the *dgMarket* website.
- Higher thresholds for MCC approval of the use of shopping as a procurement method.
- The option for MCA Entities to request language waivers to permit documents to be issued in English, Spanish, French, or a combination thereof, regardless of contract value.
