Objective:

MITRE will provide support for the Office of the Associate Chief Information Officer (AOCIO) for Cyber Security in the performance of its responsibilities. The primary task is to assist the Office of Cyber Security in enabling the Department to achieve integrated and coordinated INFOSEC planning and operation. Specifically, MITRE will assist in the following activities:

- Identify activities needed to meet INFOSEC objectives

- Identify critical milestones and schedules
- Identify measurement approaches to assess program effectiveness
- Identify areas where uniform policies and standards are needed for Department-wide consistency and secure interoperability
