### **Nevada Test Site Informational Displays at Nye County Libraries**

Three U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Nevada Site Office Environmental Management displays regarding groundwater at the Nevada Test Site (NTS) and radioactive waste transportation and disposal at the NTS are currently on exhibit at various Nye County Libraries. The public and media are invited to visit these displays at their respective locations.

A *Groundwater* display, addressing frequently asked questions regarding groundwater at the Nevada Test Site, is at the Amargosa Library at 829 East Farm Road, Amargosa Valley, Nevada. Library hours are: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

A *Low-Level Radioactive Waste Transportation* display, depicting low-level radioactive waste shipment routes to the Nevada Test Site used by approved waste generators, is currently on exhibit at the Pahrump Community Library at 701 East Street, Pahrump, Nevada. Library hours are: Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Friday and Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

A *Radioactive Waste Disposal at the Nevada Test Site* display is currently on exhibit at the Beatty Library. The timeline-design is a historical perspective of activities that took place at the Nevada Test Site from the 1950s to present day, including number of waste shipments. The Library is at 400 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street on the corner of 4<sup>th</sup> and Ward Street in Beatty, Nevada. Library hours are: Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.; Tuesday noon to 7:00 p.m., and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
