NNSA opens registration for Nevada Regional Science Bowl

The National Nuclear Security Administration Nevada Site Office is pleased to announce team registration is now open for the 14th Annual Nevada Regional Science Bowl. All high schools in Nevada, northern Arizona, eastern California and southern Utah are eligible to participate. The competition is scheduled for February 11-12, 2005, at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas campus.

The U.S. Department of Energy established the National Science Bowl in 1991 to encourage students to achieve educational excellence in the sciences. Since its inception, more than 100,000 young men and women from across the country have participated in this competition. Competing teams are quizzed on scientific topics in biology, chemistry, physics, astronomy, earth science, general science, and mathematics. Each team is composed of four students, one alternate student, and a teacher who serves as an advisor and coach.
