Below are questions that have been submitted regarding Solicitation USDC-ARE-0801 for Centrex Telephone Services, along with responses from the Court:

A. Section C.1 Specification Overview

1. Will the Courts please clarify that there are 100 BRI stations on the Centrex with 20 lines supporting in and out bound calling? **No.**
2. Or will the Courts please clarify that there are the 20 analog lines in addition to the 100 stations? **Yes and these are minimum line counts. We have approximately 170 BRIs and 40 analog lines.**
3. Will the Courts please clarify the ratio? **Ratio is 1:1. We are using lines, not trunks.**
4. Will the Courts please clarify the data ratio? **We are not requesting data services.**
5. Will the Courts please provide the current telephone numbers that the Courts are using and would like to keep? **Yes, an accurate list will be provided upon contract award. In general, we are looking to port four hundred blocks of numbers, i.e. 501-604-5100 to 501-604-5499.**

B. Section C.2.1 Features

1. Will the Courts please confirm that 6-way Conference imperative? **Yes, it is essential.**
2. Will the Courts please clarify if Voice Mail will be provided by the Court's CPE equipment or should it be supplied by the dial tone provider? **Voice mail service shall be provided by the successful bidder.**

C. C.3.4 Cabling and Wiring

1. Will the Courts please clarify if the contractor being asked to make station cross connects to actual telephone sets? **No, the court will perform that task.**
