Subject: Applicability of CCR to Procurements Related to Incidents

To: Regional Foresters, Station Directors, Area Director

It has come to my attention that a number of interpretations are being relied on to meet requirements set forth in FAR 4.11, Central Contractor Registration (CCR). The application of this Subpart shall be applied in the following manner for procurements related to incidents. These requirements apply to existing and future Contracts, EERAs, BPAs, and Land Use Agreements:

- 1. If performance of existing agreements/contracts extends beyond 12/31/2003, they must be modified to incorporate FAR clause 52.204-7, Central Contractor Registration.
- 2. The exemption found at FAR 4.1102(3)(ii), contracts awarded by Contracting Officers in the conduct of emergency operations, will only apply to procurements initiated during an incident, and not to procurements initiated pre-incident or during pre-season preparation.
- 3. The exemption found at FAR 4.1202(4), contracts to support unusual or compelling needs (see 6.302-2), will also only apply to procurements initiated during an Incident, and not to procurements initiated pre-incident or during pre-season preparation.
- 4. CCR is not required prior to an agreement/contract being signed at an Incident, as long as the expiration date does not exceed December 31st of the sign-up year.
- 5. If the agreement/contract expires after December 31st of the year awarded, registration is required prior to award with the inclusion and enforcement of the FAR Clause.
