Executive summary

The second quarter of the current contract is another building quarter. Smaller funded outreach projects are under way and the subcontract proposal period was initiated. A Request For Proposals for competitive outreach projects was announced. Proposals were submitted and reviewed by NER and the Outreach Review Subcommittee. Targeted proposals from pre-selected Outreach Libraries are also in development.

The annual North Atlantic Health Sciences Libraries (NAHSL) chapter conference took place in October. The conference was a combined event of North Atlantic and Middle Atlantic Regions. NER convened Resource Library Directors and Hospital Library Subcommittee during the chapter conference. NER and MAR held a joint DOCLINE update for attendees. An NER update was presented to all attendees at the NAHSL business meeting.

NER Director and Associate Director attended the AAHSL and AAMC annual meetings in Seattle. The meeting allowed for a visit with the Pacific Northwest Region. For a second time, NER was asked to provide PubMed instruction to libary science students at a Health Sciences Librarianship class at McGill University in Montreal.

Across the region and at venues at the combined chapter meeting, staff conducted twenty-eight presentations to 363 participants. These sessions included topics such as PubMed, consumer health, DOCLINE, and evidencebased public health resources. A technology based class "Geeks Bearing Gifts" was offered by the NER Technology Coordinator at the previously mentioned chapter conference.

Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) activities

NER Director Elaine Martin met with Boston University Alumni Library Director (Resource Library) David Ginn in August. Director Elaine Martin and Associate Director Javier Crespo met with Resource Library Directors Tovah Reis and Mary Ann Slocomb in Rhode Island. Individual meetings provide the opportunity to meet directly with medical library leaders, discuss local and institutional events related to health and libraries, and discuss future opportunities. The meeting with Rhode Island directors served to have final discussions about the impact of their previous subcontract and the feasibility of a Go Local implementation in that state.

On October 15, NER staff met with Resource Library Directors at NAHSL Annual Conference in Hartford. Staff conveyed program plans for the year and discussed task forces on historical collections and emergency planning. The Hospital Library Subcommittee was also convened on October 14 in conjunction with the Annual Conference.

The Outreach Review Subcommittee of the RAC conducted most of its work this quarter. This group reviews, scores, and comments on the competitive outreach proposals received by NER for funding.

In contrast with the ten awards issued last quarter, one new award was issued in the second quarter. UVM Librarian Nancy Bianchi contacted NER regarding a Breast Cancer Symposium being organized in Burlington, VT. The library is playing a key role and the award the support the presentation of library services as well as facilities support for an instructional session to be conducted by NER staff.

Funded projects (≥ \$15,000)

As we are in the early stages of our contract, no new outreach subcontracts have been issued. NER is in communication with Outreach Libraries who will be submitting outreach project proposals, these institutions have been predetermined.

Four project proposals were received in response to NER's Request For Proposals issued in August. NER announced the RFP through its distribution list and newsletter. Proposals were received from members libraries in Maine (2), Massachusetts, and New Hampshire. NER staff worked with the Outreach Review Subcommittee to review, comment, and select commented on the projects. Proposals were forwarded to NNO for review and approval.

NER is pleased that the proposals represent potential projects in both rural and urban communities. Rural health care providers, health educators, 6th grade students, and the growing Somali community in Central Maine are among the populations that would be served by the potential projects.

NER conducted a follow-up teleconference with the Outreach Review members to brief them to discuss their individual decision making and brief them on the final decisions made.
