4	JANICE GARDIPE: Good evening. I'm here.
5	My presentation or to meet with you guys is just
6	short. I'm here today to speak out to oppose in a
7	unified voice for my past ancestors, future
8	generations in the presence of those that can't be
9	here today of all of my native people. I speak out
10	to protect our Western Shoshone lands near Yucca
11	Mountain near the Test Site in Southern Nevada.
12	I'm Western Shoshone and my ancestors lived
13	off the land. They took care of the land, the air,
14	the water and the sacred ways for thousands of years.
15	Never in a destructive manner, only in a respectful
16	way.
17	And I'd just like to say I oppose the
18	disposal of the spent nuclear fuel and high-level
19	radiation, radioactive waste in Yucca Mountain and
20	also the rail transportation corridor and rail
21	alignment for the construction and operation of the
22	railroad in Nevada.
23	I feel strongly about that. People
24	protected the land for thousands of years, not
25	desecrating, only protecting the land in a respectful

- 1 manner. And I'm here today just to let people know
- 2 that. My speech isn't very long but hopefully it has
- 3 an impact. Thank you.
