--> Ladies And Gentlemen: I have had the opportunity to review the two supplemental DEIS on the subject of Yucca Mt. and I have submitting the following comments.

1 DOE/EIS 2050F-S1D : [The site is not safe because of the looming earthquake hazard, the Stateline Fault runs thirty miles from Yucca Mt. The problem is that the risk assessment team lacks 65 percent of the facilities leaving a lot of guesswork in their prediction on how the facilities equipment will function when a earthquake strikes. The other potential natural threats include floods and volcanic activity, the mountain itself is a 13 million year old volcanic-rock ridge.]
