- 3 (3. The draft SEIS did not include final TAD designs, so it is impossible to assess how TADs will affect the repository and transportation systems.)
- 4. The Mina Rail Corridor as a "non-preferred alternative" is not viable because of the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council's withdrawal of support, and should not have been included in the EIS.
- 5. The repository SEIS should have evaluated the impacts of legal-weight truck transport.
- 6. The impacts of the use of overweight trucks has not been analyzed.
- 7. The DEIS does not adequately address worst case accidents, severe accidents involving long duration fires, and consequences of terrorist attack.
