To Whom It May Concern:

I oppose the dumping of radioactive waste at Yucca Mountain for the following reasons:

- 1 [1. The site is within the treaty lands of the Western Shoshone Nation, and they oppose the dump.]
- 2 [2. The hydrologic basin under Yucca Mountain covers thousands of square miles and the inhabitants of this area need safe groundwater.]
- 3 [3. The draft SEIS did not include final TAD designs, so it is impossible to assess how TADs will affect the repository and transportation systems.]
- A [4. The Mina Rail Corridor as a "non-preferred alternative" is not viable because of the Walker River Paiute Tribal Council's withdrawal of support, and should not have been included in the EIS.]
- 5 [5. The repository SEIS should have evaluated the impacts of legal-weight truck transport.]
- 6 [6. The impacts of the use of overweight trucks has not been analyzed.]
- 7 [7. The DEIS does not adequately address worst case accidents, severe accidents involving long duration fires, and consequences of terrorist attack.]
