This site, Yucca Mountain, is a very poor location for nuclear waste storage.

- (1) The mountain is NOT geologically stable, sitting on a fault line; the area experienced an almost 5 point Richter scale earthquake just a few years ago.
- (2) Terrorist threats exist all along the lengthy transportation routes, both by rail and by road.
- (3) The technology being used to contain and ship the waste have failed in tests and have been falsely billed to perform beyond actual design specs.
