1 [ Please extend the public comment period, given the volume of the EIS documentation, and the inadequate time for independent analysis. ]

2 [ I am concerned that the increased transportation of sensitive waste presents a public health risk and a likely terrorist target.

I believe that the proposed concentration of waste at Yucca Mountain would also violate existing DOE regulations.

Why would this plan, which was essentially declared unviable in the 1990's, be revived as an option today?

I am also concerned about the status of the Shoshone Nation land that will be contaminated by this proposed activity.

There is ongoing evidence (reflected in recent federal court rulings) that the site is not actually suitable for disposal, and that current construction activities are squandering resources and funds to modify the site.

Many environmental groups that I respect have recorded opposition to many aspects of this overall project. I believe that a new approach is warranted. ]
