1 [I am writing to oppose the creation of a nuclear waste repository at Yucca Mountain. As a regional land use planner, I understand that it is extremely difficult to find locations to site such facilities. However, I also understand that Yucca Mountain is a an important cultural site to the Shoshone Native American tribe and that there is a vast amount of community opposition to the project.] [The Draft EIR does not adequately address the socio-economic impacts of the facility on the surrouding community and the Timbisha Shoshone Tribe, nor does its consideration of Land Ownership adequately recognize tribal attachments to the mountain. The mishandling of energy resources in this area is already internationally considered a massive human rights violation, and the siting of a nuclear waste repository there only draws more attention to this abuse.] 2
