ORDER VACATING LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA


DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1202-D

FE DOCKET NO. 96-52-NG

On September 24, 1996, the Department of Energy's (DOE) Office of Fossil Energy (FE) issued DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 1202^{1/} (Order 1202) in Docket No. 96-52-NG, as amended,^{2/} authorizing Engage Energy America L.L.C. (Engage), to import up to 48.3 thousand cubic feet per day of Canadian natural gas over an 11-year, seven month term. In a letter dated May 25, 2005, DOE was notified that Duke Energy Marketing America, LLC (DEMA) had acquired Engage and all of its assets and has no further use for the import authority. DEMA requests that DOE vacate Order 1202.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the long-term authorization granted by Order 1202, as amended, is hereby vacated.
