ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1914-A

On October 27, 2003, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Ontario Energy Savings Corp. (OESC) in DOE/FE Order No. 1914 (Order 1914) (2 FE ¶70,901) to import and export up to a combined total of 200 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on November 1, 2003, and extending through October 31, 2005. On July 18, 2005, OESC requested DOE to vacate Order 1914.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 1914, authorizing the import and export of natural gas from and to Canada, is hereby vacated.
