ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1939-A

On February 6, 2004, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Excelerate Energy L.P. (EELP) in DOE/FE Order No. 1939 (Order 1939) (2 FE ¶70,930) to import up to 400 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of liquefied natural gas (LNG) from various international sources over a two-year term beginning on December 1, 2004, and extending through November 30, 2006. On July 7, 2005, EELP requested DOE to vacate Order 1939.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 1939, authorizing the import of liquefied natural gas from various international sources, is hereby vacated.
