The Mira Corrida appears to be even more ill-advised than the Caliente Corrida, crossing even more of the state, all major waterways, and significant habitat. These two routes can't possibly represent the best thinking on transportation through Nevada. As far as transportation to Nevada, I can only hope ~~that~~ ^{more readily} emergency responders will be ~~more~~ available than in some parts of Nevada - this is a much bigger concern to me than terrorism or sabotage. The entire transportation aspect of the plan seems simplistic, and certainly not in any person's best interest.
