Untitled 17 MR. OPPENBORN: Right now there's an organization called the Citizen Advisory Board, and 18 19 it is an organization of DOE people as well as 20 contractors, scientists, and also citizens. And 21 their main function is to act as an interface between the Nevada test site and the general public. 22 23 I was wondering if Yucca Mountain was going 24 to have the same type of organization to act between 25 the Yucca Mountain project and the general public.

Contractors, scientists, and citizens would be on the
 board to act as an interface between the Yucca
 Mountain project and the general public.

4 I know that Nellis Air Force Base has a 5 similar situation. And I'm sure that Nellis would be 6 interested in having somebody on such a board since 7 the railroad tracks going into Yucca Mountain skirt 8 the Nellis test and training range. Nellis would be 9 interested in having a representative on such a board to represent the interests of the Air Force, as well 10 11 as the general public, to voice their concerns to the 12 DOE and, vice versa, DOE to voice their concerns to 13 us, the Air Force.

14 I'm sure Yucca Mountain representatives may
15 be interested in joining the board on Nellis Air
16 Force Base since the two entities are right next to
17 each other, that is, Yucca Mountain and the Nellis
18 test and training range. So that may be something
19 that DOE may want to look into. That's it.
