My Health Minnesota \rightarrow **Go Local** is a free, online database of health services throughout Minnesota. It's linked to **MedlinePlus.gov**, a free website from the National Library of Medicine that provides trusted, reliable health information.

You can access My Health Minnesota \rightarrow Go Local by searching for health information on MedlinePlus and linking to Minnesota from any of the health topics pages. For example, from the page for diabetes, you

can link to related services in Minnesota using the Go Local drop-down menu on the right side of the page.
