

**Amendment to H.R. 2419**  
**Offered by Ms. Foxx**

This amendment reduces reserve funding for Sec. 31, National Organic Certification Cost-Share Program by \$3 million and redirects this reserve funding into Sec. 32, Organic Production and Market Data Collection.

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2419**  
**OFFERED BY MS. FOXX**

**(Page and line numbers refer to the Chairman's mark of the  
Horticulture and Organic Agriculture title posted on June 5)**

Page 23, line 1, insert after the dollar amount, relating to the National Organic Certification Cost-Share Program, the following: “(reduced by \$3,000,000)”.

Page 23, strike line 22 and all that follows through line 7 on page 24, and insert the following:

1 **“SEC. 7407. ORGANIC DATA COLLECTION AND PUBLICA-**  
2 **TION.**

3 “(a) DATA COLLECTION AND PUBLICATION.—To as-  
4 sist organic farmers in making informed production and  
5 marketing decisions, the Secretary of Agriculture shall col-  
6 lect and publish segregated data and survey information  
7 about the price, production, and marketing of major or-  
8 ganically produced commodities, as determined by the Sec-  
9 retary.

10 “(b) CONTINGENT FUNDING.—In title XI of the  
11 **【2007 Farm Bill】**—

12 “(1) if a change in law or laws not pertaining  
13 to this section reduces outlays and/or increases rev-  
14 enue by an amount sufficient to offset the increased

1 outlays that would occur over the period of fiscal  
2 years 2007 through 2012 and the period of fiscal  
3 years 2007 through 2017 if funds were provided  
4 under paragraph (3) for fiscal years 2008 through  
5 2012 (as estimated by the House Committee on the  
6 Budget at the time of enactment of this Act); and

7 “(2) if such reductions in outlays or increases  
8 in revenue in paragraph (1) are specifically and ex-  
9 clusively dedicated to providing funds under para-  
10 graph (3); then

11 “(3) the Secretary of Agriculture shall use  
12 \$3,000,000 of funds of the Commodity Credit Cor-  
13 poration to carry out this section during fiscal year  
14 2008, and such funds shall remain available until  
15 expended.”.
