
What is a Junior Ranger?

- A Junior Ranger is someone who helps keep Lake Berryessa clean, safe and fun for all to enjoy.
- A Junior Ranger learns about the environment, water safety, and conserving water, and then tells others about what they learned.
- To become a Junior Ranger all you have to do is complete the activities in this book, and pledge to keep Lake Berryessa clean, safe and nice.
- Ages 5-8 should complete 4 activities in this book. Ages 9-12 should complete all the activities in this book. Once they have been completed, show a Park Ranger at Oak Shores, the Visitor Center, or headquarters to become an official Junior Ranger.

Hello! I'm Ranger McBill and I will be leading you through the Lake Berryessa Junior Ranger Activity Book. There is a lot to learn and we can use your help to keep Lake Berryessa clean, safe and beautiful.



Before we get started on the activities, I want to tell you a little history about the lake.

Did you know that Lake Berryessa is a man-made lake? It has only been here since 1957. Can you tell me how many years ago that was?

Before the lake was here, this area was a farming town named Monticello. Water was needed for drinking and farming in other communities around the area, so Monticello Dam was built to create the lake. The townspeople of Monticello moved to other places to do their farming.

Not only do other towns get water from Lake Berryessa, but people from all around get to enjoy fishing, boating, waterskiing, wakeboarding, camping, picnicking, and many other fun activities all year long!

Now that you know how the lake was created, let's find out the best ways to keep it safe and fun for everyone!

Let's take a walk and use four of our five senses, **seeing**, **hearing**, **touching** and **smelling**, to describe what you experienced at Lake Berryessa.








Using your magnifying glass, **draw** some pictures of something you **saw** up close.

- Use a broom instead of a water hose to clean driveways and sidewalks.





 You must have a LIFE JACKET for each person on the boat




• An **ANCHOR** is important to have if you want to stay in one place on the lake








Bird Identification




This bird is the second largest waterfowl found in North America. They can weigh up to 24 pounds.



This bird is California's state bird and is seen in groups called coveys that can range from 10 to 200 birds.








This bird is nocturnal which means it is active at night. It uses its amazing hearing and night vision to hunt small animals.

Large groups of this bird are called a flock. The Males are much more brightly colored and have a beard.






