Insert at the appropriate place the following:

1 SEC. ____ DOCUMENTATION OF IDENTITY.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
3 sion of law, any individual undergoing a determination of
4 the individual's eligibility for medical assistance under title
5 XIX of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.)
6 or child health assistance under title XXI of such Act (42
7 U.S.C. 1397aa et seq.) shall submit (or, in the case that
8 the individual is a minor, a parent or guardian of such
9 individual shall submit) satisfactory documentation of
10 identity (as defined in subsection (c)) to obtain such med-
11 ical or child health assistance.

12 (b) SPECIAL RULE FOR REDETERMINATIONS.—Any
13 individual who did not submit satisfactory documentation
14 of identity during any previous determination or redeter-
15 mination of their eligibility for such medical or child health
16 assistance shall submit such documentation during the
17 first redetermination of the individual's eligibility for such

1 assistance that occurs on or after the effective date of this
2 section.

3 (c) SATISFACTORY DOCUMENTATION OF IDENTITY
4 DEFINED.—For purposes of this section, the term “satis-
5 factory documentation of identity” means the following:

6 (1) Any identity document described in section
7 274A(b)(1)(D) of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act.

9 (2) Any other physical documentation of per-
10 sonal identity of such other type as the Secretary
11 finds, by regulation, provides a reliable means of
12 identification.

13 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall be effec-
14 tive for determinations and redeterminations occurring on
15 or after July 1, 2009.
