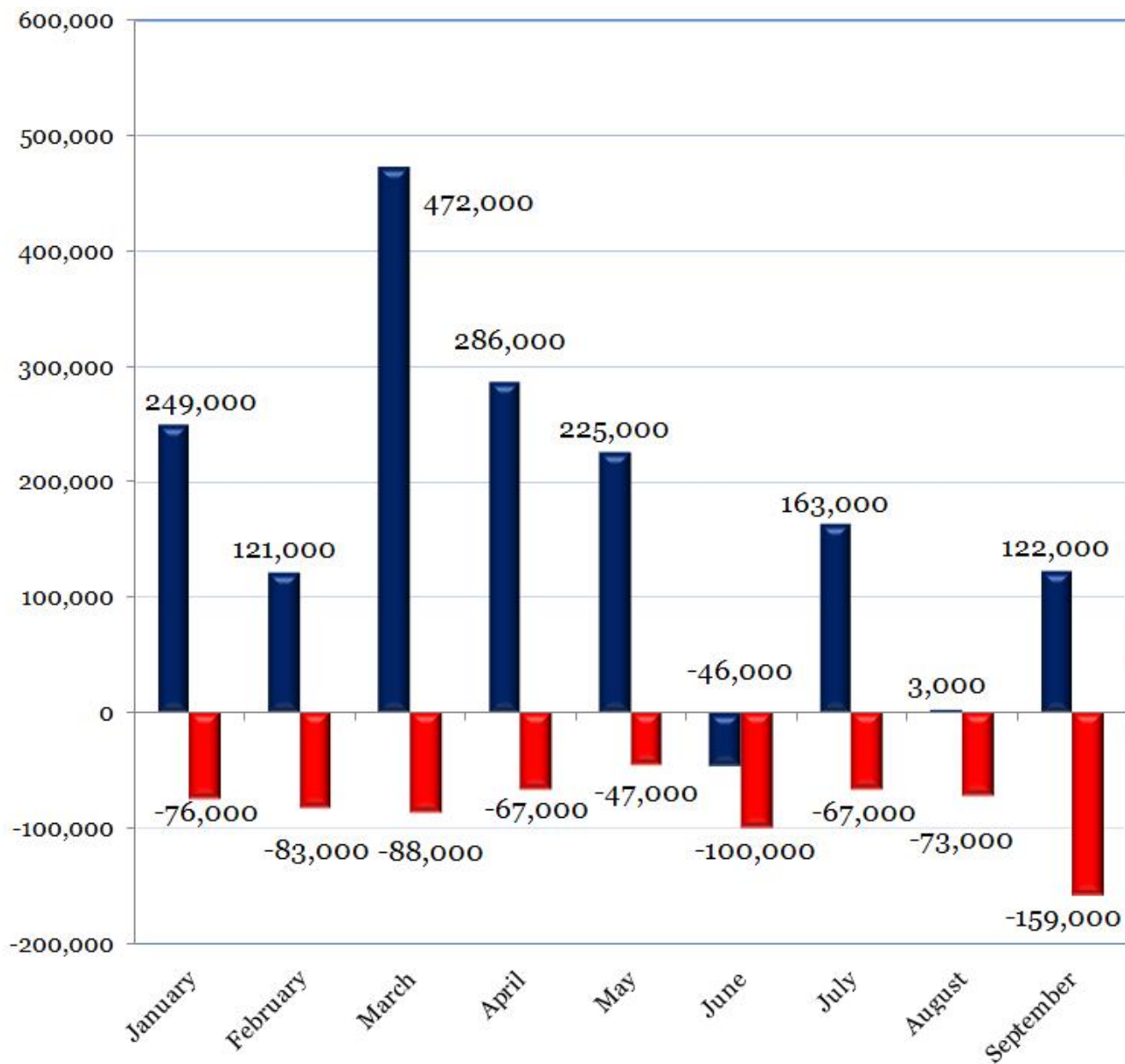


Jobs Created Through September in Clinton's Final Year v. Jobs Lost Through September in Bush's Final Year

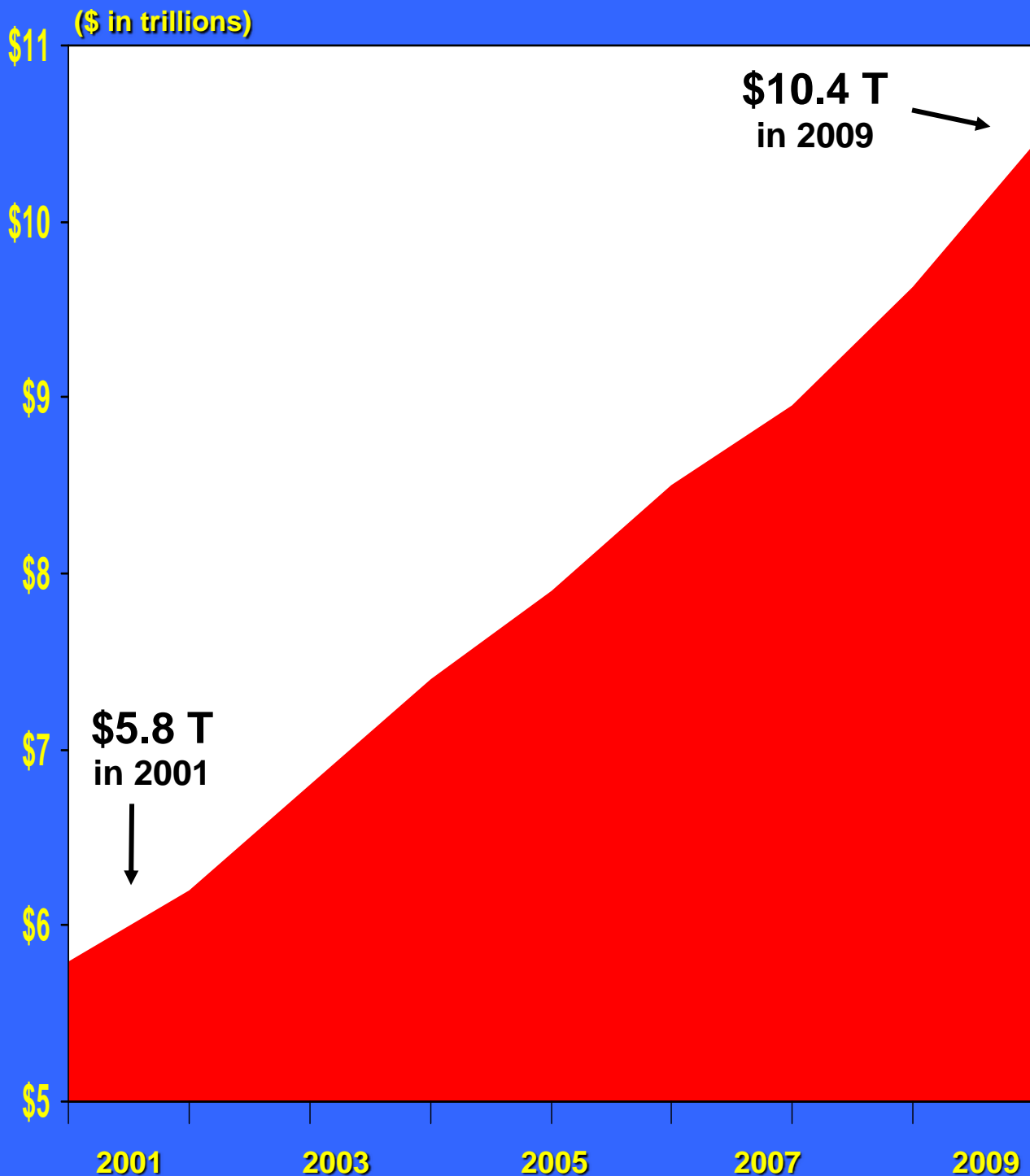


■ 1.595 Million Jobs Created Under Clinton, January – September 2000

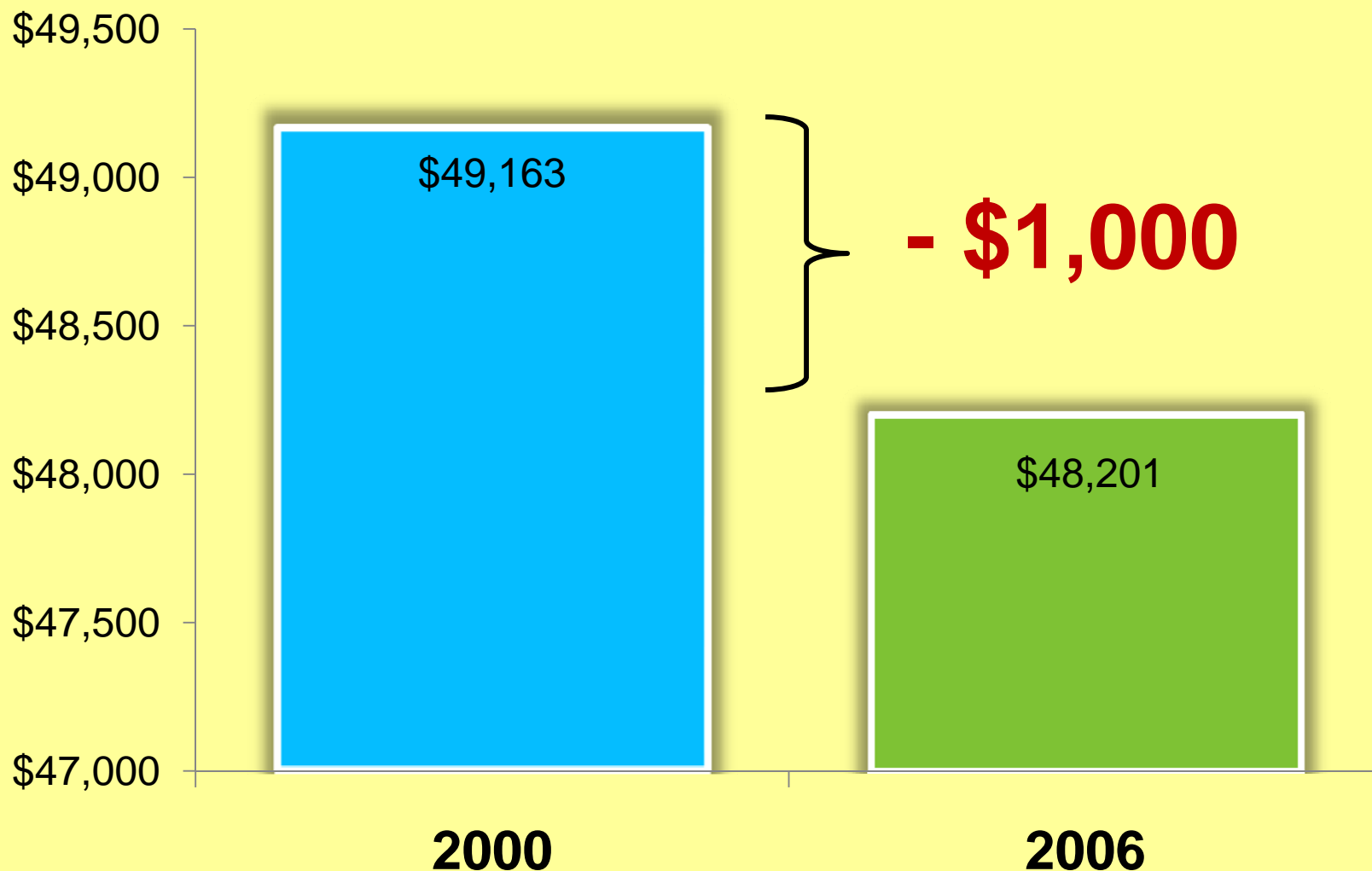
Gross Federal Debt Soars

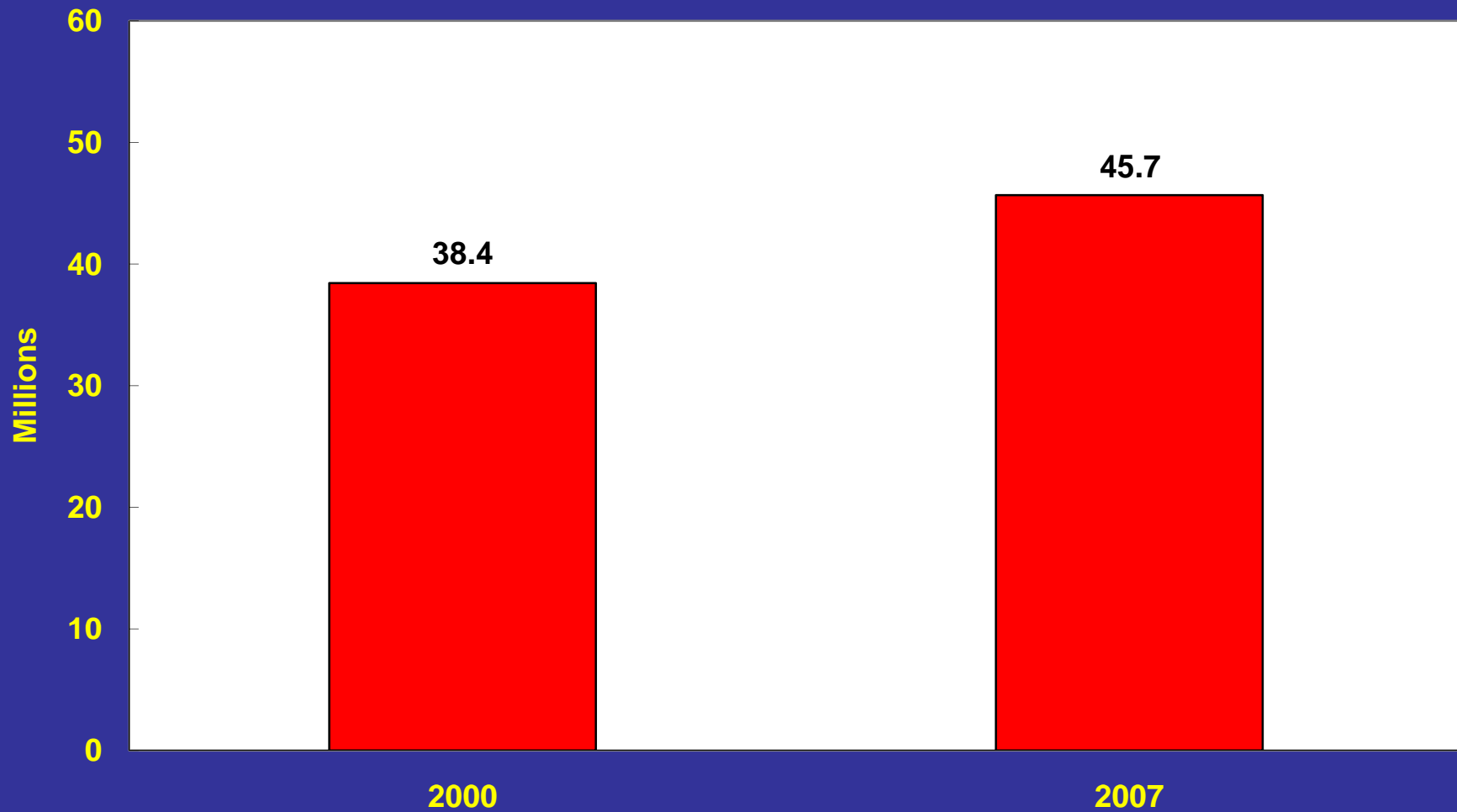
Typical Family Income Decreases Under Bush Administration

Number of People Without Health Insurance



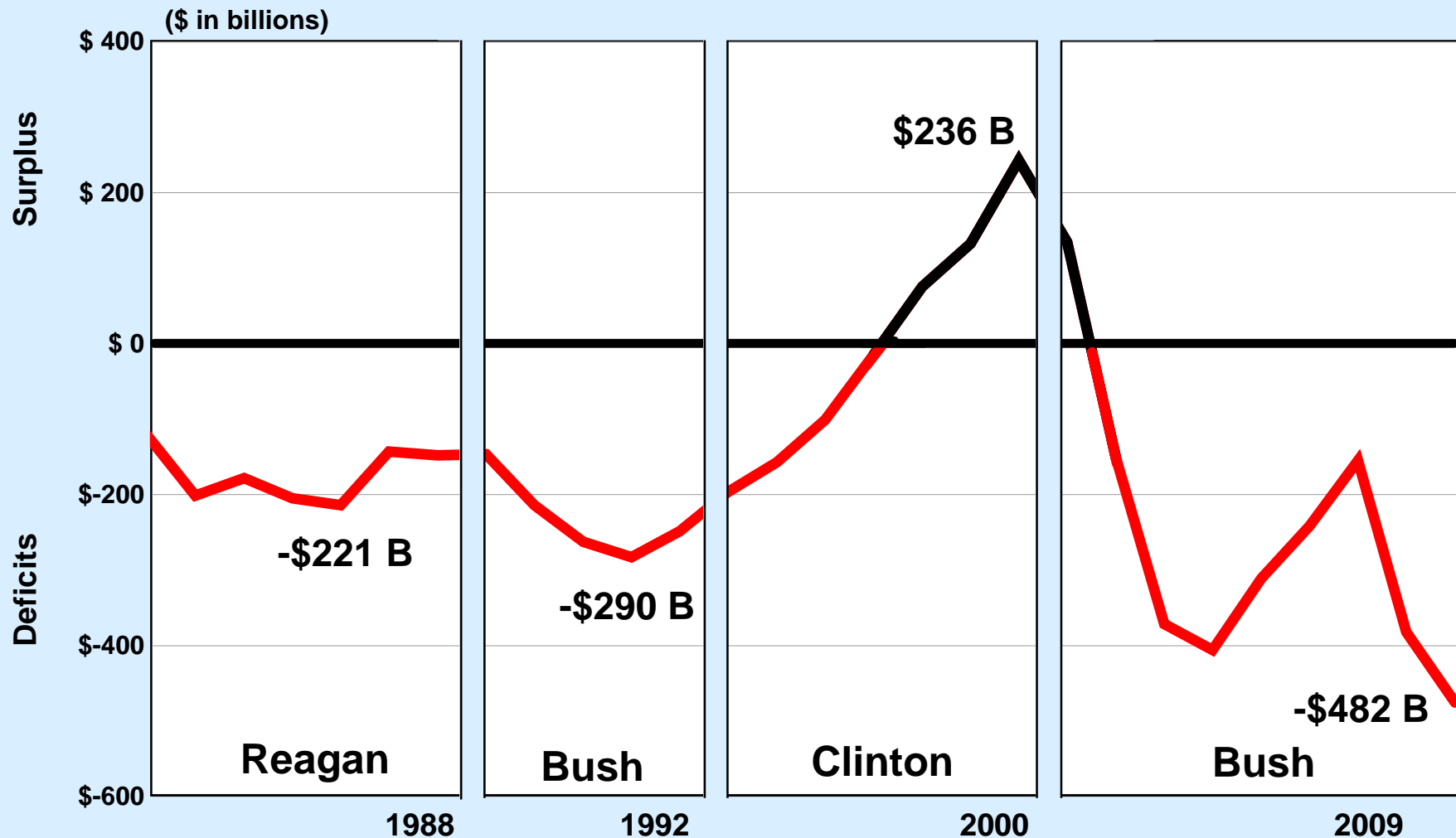

Reagan vs. Bush vs. Clinton vs. Bush Fiscal Record

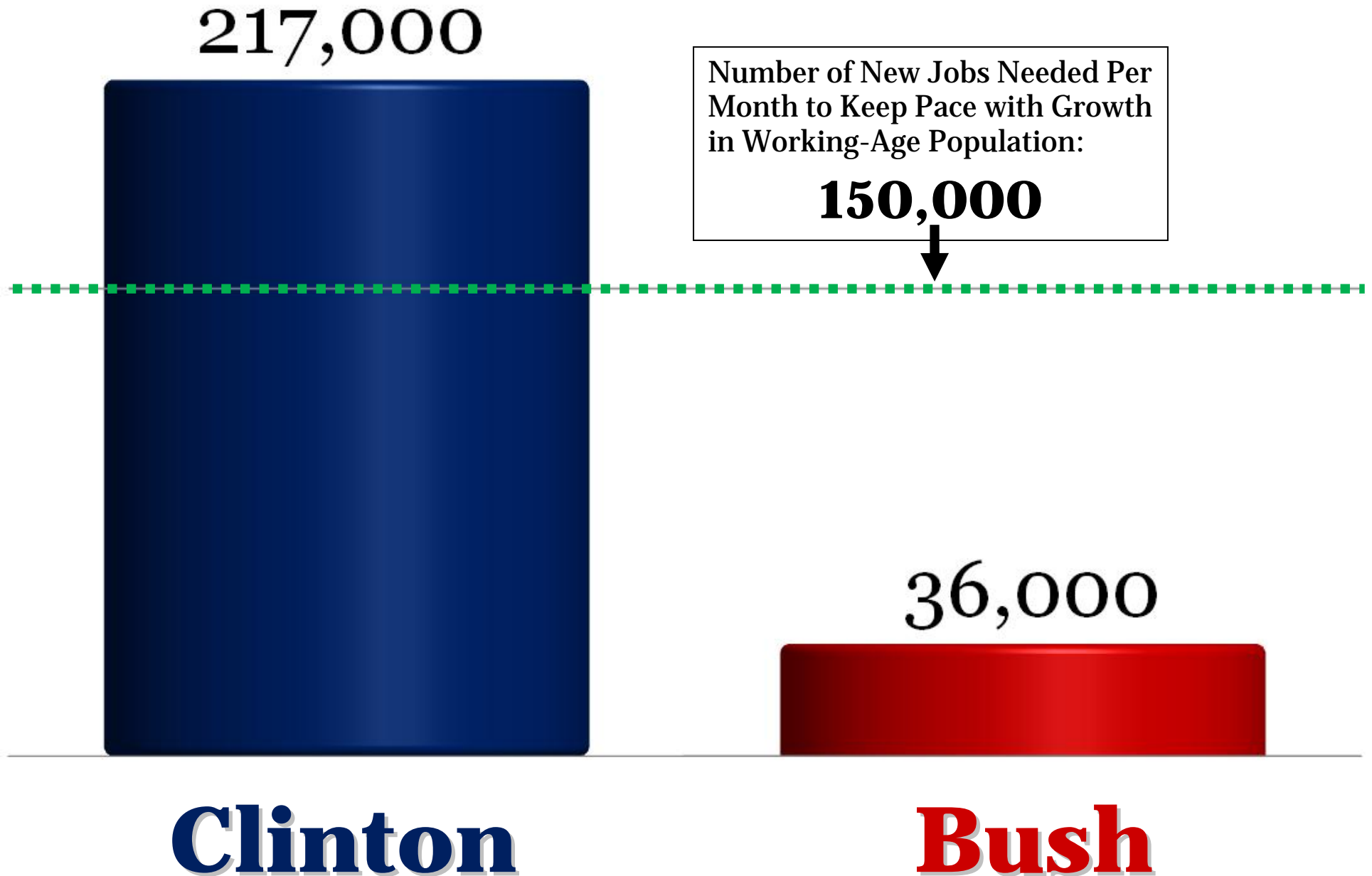

(average monthly growth)

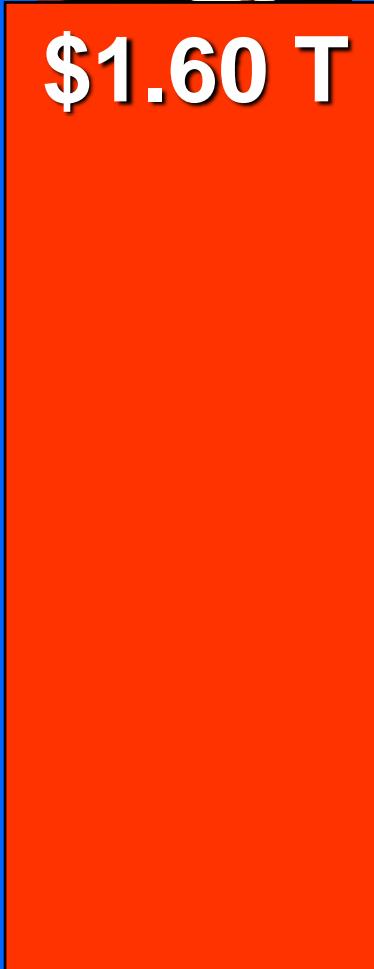


President Bush More than Doubles Foreign-Held Debt

It Took 42 Presidents 224 Years to Build Up \$1 Trillion of Foreign-Held Debt



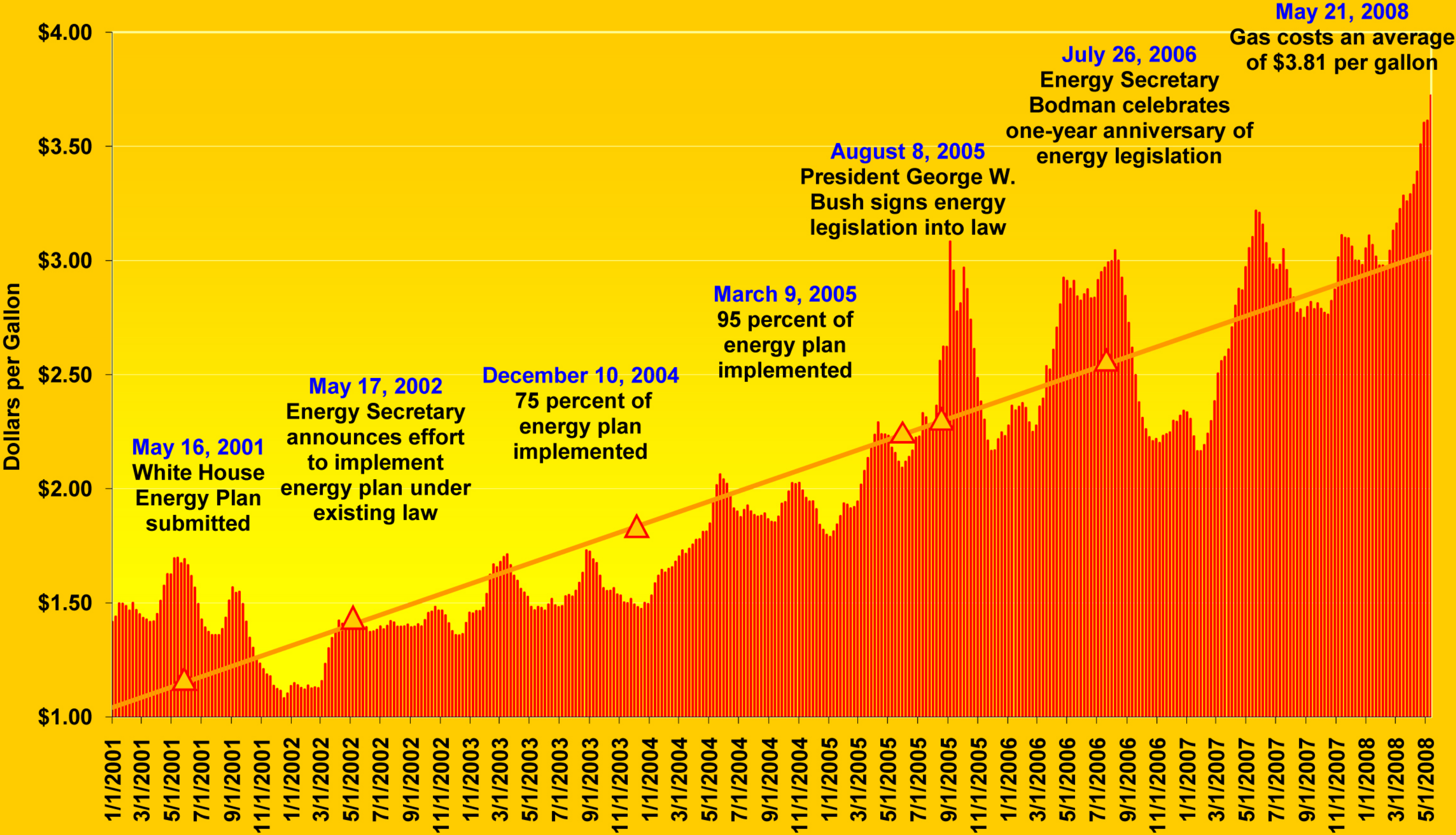

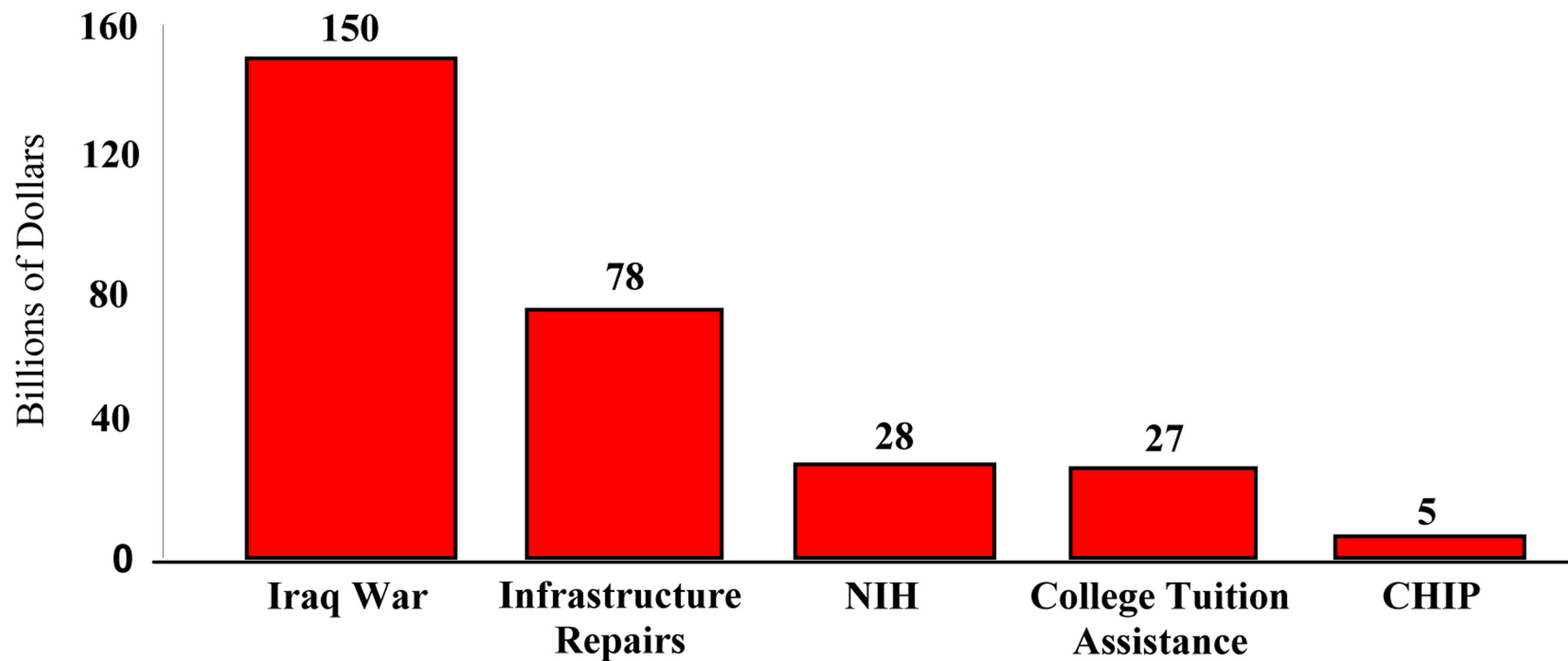
Bush Administration Energy Plan Fails America
